We learned that Antibiotics are powerful medications which fight bacterial infections by destroying bad bacteria that cause illness, unfortunately they also destroy good bacteria. **Probiotics** can help replace good bacteria in our gut by eating (yoghurt, soft cheese, sourdough bread, fermented foods etc). **Prebiotics** help feed up the good bacteria in the digestive tract (bananas, onions, leeks, asparagus, artichokes etc). What an interesting topic, relevant and helpful to all of us, I only hope that I have got all the fact right.
